- 1 everybody write their own reports or is there only one
- 2 report per investigation?
- 3 A One. Typically one report per investigation.
- 4 Q Okay. And when you were writing your narrative, where
- 5 were you getting information about what the other
- 6 officers did?
- 7 A Word of mouth.
- 8 Q Okay. From those officers or from other people or?
- 9 A Those officers.
- 10 Q Okay. And approximately what time did you finishing
- typing out your narrative?
- 12 A Maybe 7 a.m. took about five hours. Five, six hours I'd
- 13 say.
- 14 Q Okay. Did you ultimately see any other property besides
- 15 the scale that was recovered in this case?
- 16 A I did.
- 17 Q What else did you observe?
- 18 A I could reference my report for the list of everything
- specifically if that's what you're asking.
- 20 Q If that would refresh your recollection.
- 21 A Okay.
- 22 Q Where did you first observe anything else that was
- 23 confiscated?
- 24 A I first observed them in Mr. Walker when Officer Collop
- 25 showed me what was in his pocket.
